Media Coverage and Recording in the Fifth Judicial Circuit

To assist with media accommodations in often-crowded courtrooms, members of the media wishing to cover a court proceeding should submit the **request to record** form before arriving at the courthouse.

Courtroom Access

Unless otherwise specified by the presiding Judge, seating in the courtroom for members of the press is on a first-come, first-served basis. Members of the media are requested to dress appropriately. Food and drinks are not permitted. Cell phones should be turned off or placed on silent.

Recording

Recording images of any kind is prohibited without prior approval. Fill out the <u>Recording Request Form</u> to request permission to record. The recording of Jurors is not permitted.

Pooling

It is recommended that a pool camera is designated amongst any interested parties wishing to obtain footage at the courthouse. Trials require a minimum of 48-hour notice by filling out the Recording Request Form

Security

To expedite entry into the courthouse, advanced approval is needed. Security is provided with a list of authorized media outlets that have been approved to enter the building.

Media Parking

Media stations who plan on parking satellite trucks should contact the Court Operations Manager in the county you wish to cover, to ensure that they abide by parking in designated media areas. A minimum of 24-hour notice is required. (Contact information found below)

Live Shots- The media may set up for the live shots outside the courthouse. Recording inside the courthouse is NOT permitted. Please do not block any entrances or exits or security will remove you from the premises.
