WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statute 28.06, deputy clerks are deputized to conduct business on the Clerk's behalf; and,


WHEREAS, prior to business operations commencing on January 7th, all deputy clerks will be deputized; and,

2. The office hours will be 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
